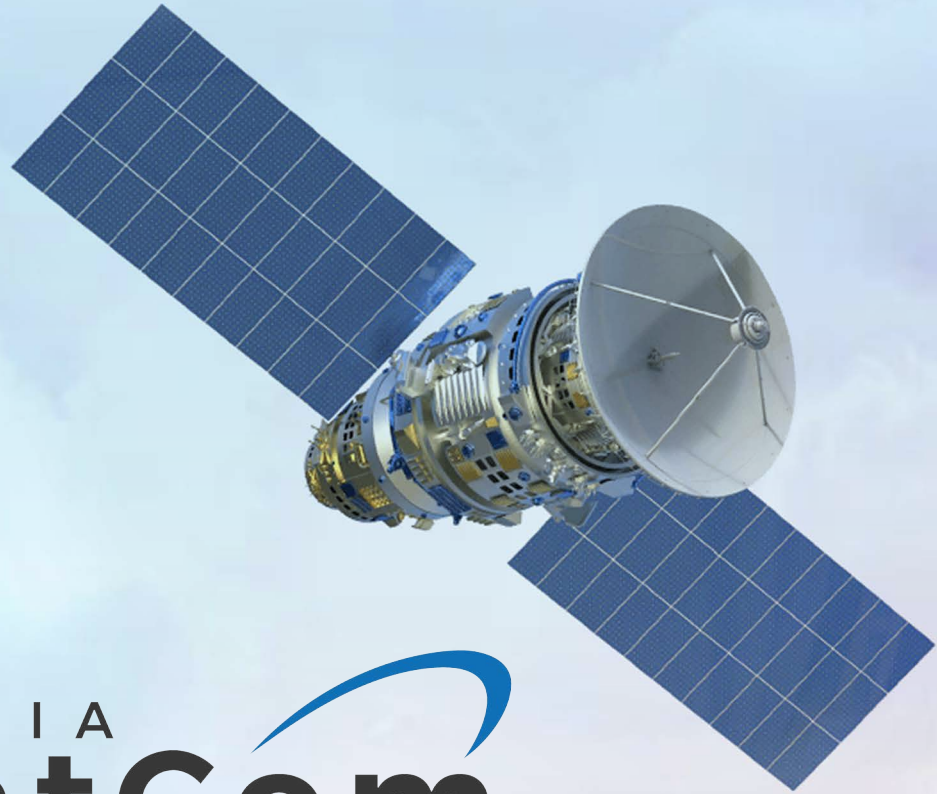

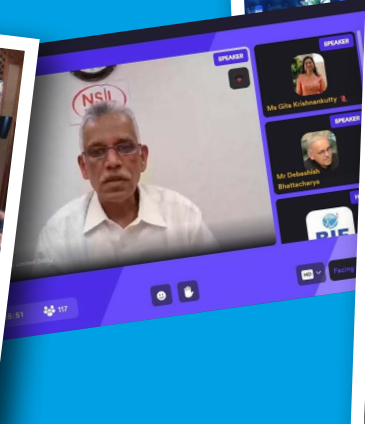
INDIA SATCOM – JOURNEY SINCE 2015
